VIRTUAL ROTARY-APRIL 5, 2021: DR. MATT BROWNING, CLEMSON UNIVERSITY-THE HEALTH BENEFITS OF NATURE

Dr. Matthew Browning is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Park, Recreation, and Tourism Management at Clemson University. His research takes place at the nexus of environmental science and public health, with a focus on examining the ways in which nature experience benefits mental and physical health, and potential causal mechanisms underlying these relationships. His training is in forestry, environmental science, and human dimensions of natural resources and holds degrees from Oberlin College, Virginia Tech, Yale School for the Environment. He has also worked as a park ranger in Utah, Iowa, and North Carolina. He is a faculty scholar in the Clemson School for Public Health Research as well as the Institute for Parks. Finally, he directs the Virtual Reality and Nature Lab, which applies an interdisciplinary, technological focus to the study of people's connections and interactions with the natural world.


