# Amazon in talks to launch tech program in Metro schools

Amazon.com Inc. wants to help Nashville build its tech-talent pipeline. To do so, the e-commerce giant is going back to the beginning: kindergarten.

The Seattle-based heavyweight is in talks with Metro Nashville Public Schools to bring its "Amazon Future Engineer" program to the city's school system this fall, according to [Holly Sullivan](#), one of the executives spearheading Amazon's Nashville expansion. Sullivan's remarks came during the Nashville Rotary Club's weekly luncheon Monday.

The program — which Amazon launched last year in Seattle — is a "comprehensive childhood-to-career program to inspire, educate and train children and young adults from underserved and low-income communities to pursue careers in computer science," according to [the company's website](#).
