Amazon in talks to launch tech program in Metro schools

Amazon.com Inc. wants to help Nashville build its tech-talent pipeline. To do so, the e-commerce giant is going back to the beginning: kindergarten.

The Seattle-based heavyweight is in talks with Metro Nashville Public Schools to bring its "Amazon Future Engineer" program to the city's school system this fall, according to Holly Sullivan, one of the executives spearheading Amazon's Nashville expansion. Sullivan's remarks came during the Nashville Rotary Club's weekly luncheon Monday.



The program — which Amazon launched last year in Seattle — is a "comprehensive childhood-to-career program to inspire, educate and train children and young adults from underserved and low-income communities to pursue careers in computer science," according to the company's website.
