VIRTUAL ROTARY-JULY 20, 2020: SCHOOL REOPENING TASK FORCE

How and when schools reopen this fall is a complicated issue. We have assembled many of Nashville's stakeholders to talk through what factors are involved in reopening schools safely.

Moderator: Dr. Maya Bugg, CEO, TN Charter School Center Panelists:

Dr. Adrienne Battle, Director of Schools, MNPS-With 167 schools and a budget of nearly \$1 billion, MNPS is one of the nation's largest school districts and one of Nashville's largest employers. Dr. Battle, a Nashville native, has spent almost her entire career with MNPS. She is a graduate of the district's John Overton High School, Missouri State University, and Tennessee State University, where she earned her master's degree and doctorate in Educational Administration and Supervision.

Dr. Alex Jahangir, Metro COVID Task Force Chair-Alex Jahangir, MD, director of orthopedic trauma at Vanderbilt Medical Center in Nashville, was appointed March 14 to head the city's Metro Coronavirus Task Force. Dr. Jahangir is an orthopedic surgeon and co-founder of the Vanderbilt Orthopedic Institute Center for Health Policy.

Todd Dickson, Founder & CEO, Valor Collegiate Academies-Since inception, Valor has been the top performing academic charter network in Tennessee. Valor has also developed a nationally recognized comprehensive human development approach, Compass, that is a key driver of their success - they are currently scaling Compass to over 200 schools around the country.
