#### How do I sponsor a new member?

The best way to recruit a new member is to let them see Rotary in action.

- 1. Bring a prospective member to a meeting. <u>Click here to register a prospective member.</u> No guest fees are charged for prospective members.
- 2. Follow up with an email inviting your guest to become a member.

The member application is found here.

3. Let Olivia know at <a href="mailto:olivia@nashvillerotary.org">olivia@nashvillerotary.org</a>. She will follow up with an email explaining how to apply for membership.

#### Who makes a good member?

- -Leaders in the community and business community
- -Leaders of diverse backgrounds
- -Executives at companies in your network
- -Members of your Leadership Nashville class
- -Honorees in your 40 Under 40 cohort

#### What's the process to join?

- 1. Prospective member fills out application found here
- 2. Prospective member is published in the weekly Rotations newsletter
- 3. If no written objections are filed, prospective member receives an email and initial invoice 10 days after his/her name is published in the newsletter

#### What's your role as a sponsor?

- -Invite your new member to be an active Rotarian both at meetings and through service projects
- -Introduce your new member to other Rotarians
- -Formally introduce your new member at a meeting

#### What is the cost to join?

- -\$400 one-time initiation fee
- -\$1300 annual membership dues (paid quarterly)
- -Gift to the NRST Footprint Fund encouraged
- -Every Rotarian Every Year gift encouraged

#### What are the rules?

You'll get credit for all new members that you sponsor and who move completely through the membership process by November 30.

Consider quality over quantity when considering sponsorship.

The Southwest prize package will be awarded to the Rotarian who sponsored the most new members.

A drawing for The Shameless Plug will occur on December 2. You will be entered into the drawing one for every new member sponsored.
