Speaker: Jon Robinson, General Manager, Tennessee Titans



Put on your Titans gear and join us in welcoming Jon Robinson. Jon Robinson enters his fourth season as the team's general manager. He was hired in January of 2016 and was promoted in 2017 to executive vice president/general manager. Robinson's work in his first three years helped the team go from three wins in the season prior to his arrival to three consecutive 9-7 seasons and a Divisional Round playoff finish following the 2017 campaign. He became the fifth general manager in franchise history to have the team in the playoffs within his first two full seasons. Robinson also is the only general manager during the "Titans" era (1999-present) to oversee three consecutive winning seasons.

Nearly 300 Rotarians and four Mayoral Candidates gathered for Nashville Rotary's Mayoral Candidate Forum on July 22.

From The Tennessean (Yihyun Jeong): In one of the last forums before the Aug. 1 election, Nashville's major candidates for mayor spoke downtown Monday at the Rotary Club of Nashville.

From transportation to aging Nashvillians, Mayor David Briley and challengers state Rep. John Ray Clemmons, At-large Council member John Cooper and retired Vanderbilt professor Carol Swain discussed several key issues facing Nashville.

They made their last-minute pitches to the crowd of business and civic leaders at the Wildhorse Saloon on why they should be elected to the city's top post.

The forum, hosted by political analyst Pat Nolan, who asked member submitted questions, largely focused on education, affordable housing and transportation.
