VIRTUAL ROTARY-AUGUST 10, 2020: SUSAN EDWARDS, CEO, FRIST ART MUSEUM

Susan Edwards has served as Executive Director and CEO of the Frist Art Museum (formerly Frist Center for the Visual Arts) in Nashville, Tennessee, since 2004. During her tenure, the Frist was awarded accreditation by the American Alliance of Museums and has presented more than two hundred critically acclaimed and popular exhibitions. Those exhibitions range from the international gem *The Birth of Impressionism: Masterpieces from the Musée d'Orsay* and the national interest project *We Shall Overcome: Nashville Press Photographs of the Civil Rights Era* to the poignant exhibition and performance *Nick Cave: Feat.*, which traveled nationally. Edwards, who holds a doctorate from the City University of New York (CUNY) Graduate Center, is an acknowledged expert in the history of photography and American art. She has taught these and other subjects at New York University, Queens College/CUNY, School of Visual Arts, New York, and Vanderbilt University. She is a regular contributor to exhibition catalogues, has curated dozens of exhibitions, and written over 40 scholarly articles for national and international publications. Dr. Edwards was appointed a Chevalier dans l'Ordre des Arts and des Lettres by the French Government in 2011. She was a Founding Fellow at the Liguria Study Center for the Arts & Humanities, Genoa, Italy. She is a member of numerous professional organizations and serves on the membership committee of the Association of Art Museum Directors. She is also on the advisory board of the Bogliasco Foundation and the Collections Committee for Harvard Art Museums.

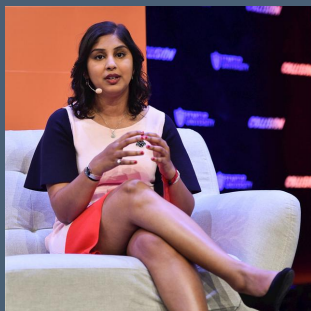

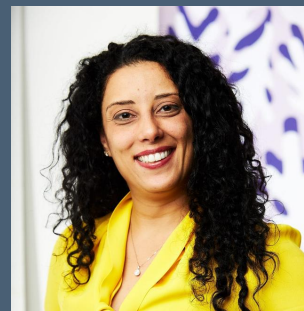

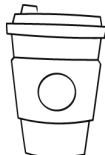
