District Training Sessions in September

Three training sessions will take place on Saturday, September 28, at Stone Memorial High School in Crossville.

1. **PETS Orientation** for Presidents-Elect and Assistant Governors starts at 8:30 a.m. Central Time and goes until noon.
2. **Global Grant Training** is required for any club that participates in a global grant in 2020- 21. That session is from 9:00 a.m. Central Time to 11:30 a.m.
3. **District Grant Training** is required for any club participating in a district grant in 2020-21. This session goes from 12:30 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. Central Time. Participation in either grant training session will count toward club qualification.

National Suicide Prevention Lifeline with Bruce Marshall



Last week Bruce Marshall shared with us about the terrible impact of suicide in our community, the state of Tennessee, and the nation. Bruce shared that the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline is not merely a centralized call center taking in calls from around the country; it is a patchwork safety net utilizing local providers like Contact Care Line, which handles calls for much of Tennessee. This important service is staffed locally by students and volunteers trained in the essentials of active listening.
