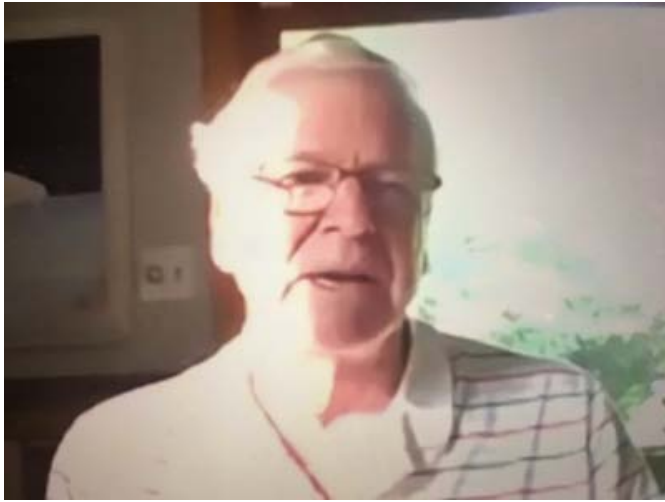










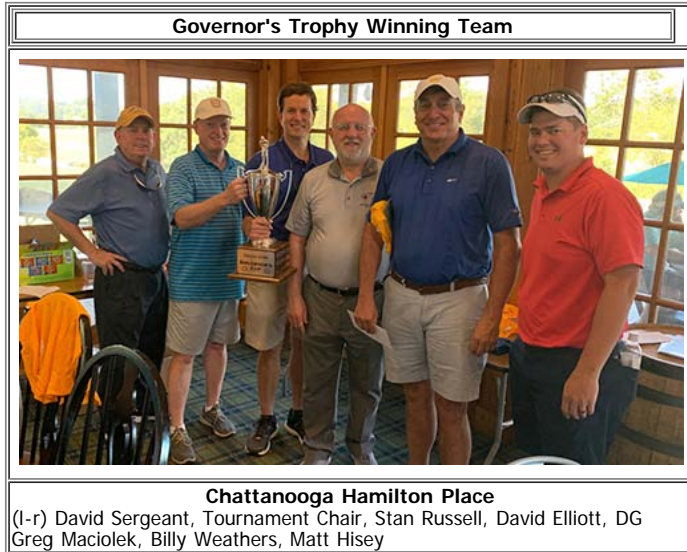


District Golf Tournament Results
