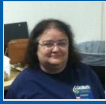

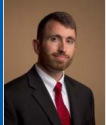

### Announcements

Ruby announced that the dues for this year will be billed in two separate payments. We ♦ will receive the invoice for the first payment soon.

### Club Assembly: President, Ruby Miller shared information about Rotary International and outlined her goals for ORBRC this year.

Holger Knaack is the new resident of Rotary International this year. The six areas of interest for RI are:

- Saving Mothers and Children
- Local economies
- Disasters, the Environment and its diversity

Ron Appuhn, a member of the Maryville Club, is our new District Governor. Assistant DG is Debbie Farmer of Jacksboro.

Ruby has set an ambitious group of goals for ORBRC. They include
