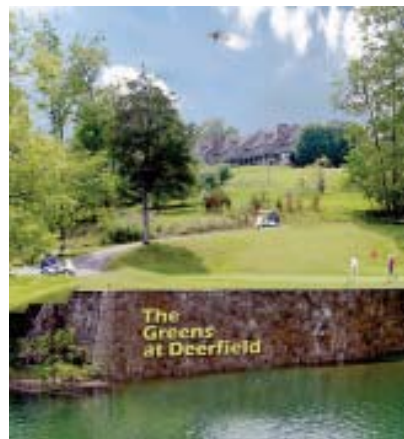

## Hit Some Balls with the South Campbell County Club



The SouthCampbell County Club will hold the Tommy C. Stiner Memorial Golf Outing on Wednesday, October 6, at the Greens at Deerfield in LaFollette. Colonel Tommy C. Stiner (US Army Ret.) was a champion of the human condition, a patriot in the truest sense of the word.

The Greens at Deerfield is a Par 71 6,700-yard championship public golf course. Its bent grass greens and Bermuda fairways are in superb condition, and the views of Norris Lake are incredible.
