## Purple Pinkie Donuts Fundraiser a Hugh Success!



World Polio Day Fundraiser was a hugh success! While the goal was \$1,000,000, a total of \$1.2 was raised with all of the donation matches. This year four other Districts took part: D6760 (West Tennessee), D6800 Memphis and Northern Mississippi), D6860 and D6880 (Alabama Districts).

Almost 5,400 boxes of ten donuts were pre-ordered. There are ten donuts to a box. A total of 55,000 donuts were made so that there would be some for walk-up donations.

Additionally, there were donations of close to \$18,000 that helped push us over the top.

A big thank you to all of the Rotarians and their friends and families that helped make this fundraiser such a hugh success. Also thanks to all of the walk-up customers who donated \$2 to the cause.
