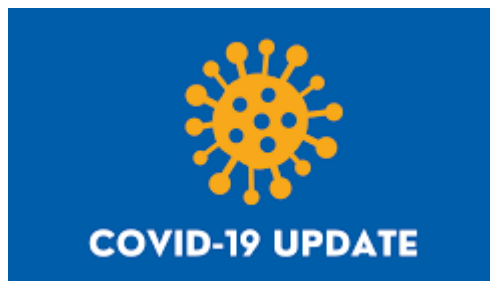

Given the latest developments of the continued spread of COVID-19 we have adjusted our approach to in-person meetings to protect the health of our members and guests, and the community at large. After consulting with local health and infectious disease experts, the following changes took effect at our August 23, 2021 meeting:

- Everyone entering our meeting areas are encouraged to wear a mask, except when eating.
