Leandra Y. Celaya, MSc **Director of Operations, International Programs** and the Executive Doctoral Program in Healthcare Leadership **UAB Department of Health Services Administration**

Leandra Y. Celaya is a faculty member in the Department of Health Services Administration in the School of Health Professions at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Her current responsibilities include managing operations for the Executive Doctoral Program in Healthcare Leadership and the Department's growing global educational partnerships. Her administrative responsibilities include strategic planning, program operations, logistics, writing and negotiating contracts, and coordinating with in-country contacts to execute programs such as international health system visits and the Executive Master of Science in Health Administration at in Saudi Arabia. Ms. Celaya's responsibilities also include developing international relationships and projects for the Department of Health Services Administration.

She is involved in many other university activities, including the UAB Fulbright Committee, the Sparkman Global Scholars Program and the UAB Global Citizenship Committee where she represents the School of Health Professions. She is co-chair of the HSA Diversity, Equity and Inclusion committee and is a UAB Diversity Ambassador and Diversity Education Facilitator.

Her teaching responsibilities include a course on Cultural Intelligence in the Healthcare Management undergraduate program, a synthesis/capstone course for the Executive MSHA program, graduate-level courses on Marketing, and advising doctoral students through their dissertation research. She also provides consultation for her fellow faculty members in instructional design for executive education and in developing more inclusive teaching practices.

Her scholarly work includes a publication in Cross Cultural Management: An International Journal, in a topic that is relevant to her interest in cross-cultural communication: "Pre-Departure Cultural Training: US Managers in Mexico." She has presented on the Department's international and DEI work at both national and international meetings. In addition, she served as co-editor of the special issue on management of culture and cultural change in healthcare organizations of the European Journal of Cross-Cultural Competence and Management.
