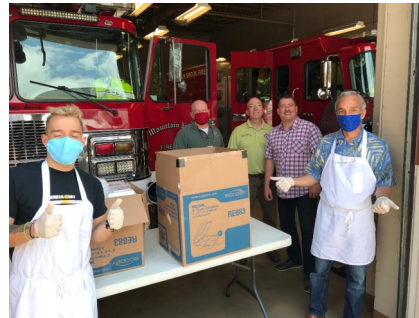


Meals for “Heroes”
