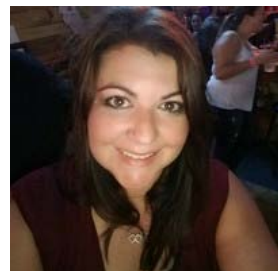

## Stano Foundation Request

It has been brought to our club's attention that our fellow Rotarian, Paula Stano, of the Stano Foundation needs our help in continuing her foundations efforts to support our troops overseas. The foundation sends care packages to troops deployed and due to the circumstances of Covid not only are her supplies greatly reduced but her ability to raise donations has also been negatively affected. This was brought to our attention when Jason Contino reached out to her to find out how to get some of the packages delivered to a friend he has deployed currently in Afghanistan.

Therefore, we are asking if members can bring in both supplies and monetary donations (to cover the costs of the shipping). Each box cost approximately \$20 to ship and we are going to ship 20 boxes.

One of the particular items that was requested were black or brown boot socks. Paula has enough of the Bombas socks to add to the packages. But we will still need:

Flavor packets to add to water bottles (powder)

KCups

Snacks (like beef jerky etc)

We will collect the supplies over the next 2-3 weeks, but will need volunteers to pack the care packages in 3 weeks.
