## Speaker, Friday July 31st: Emily Stevenson, co-founder Beach Guardian CIC

### Speaker

Emily Stevenson, co-founder Beach Guardian CIC

### Topic

Plastic Pollution and Personal Power

### Bio

Emily Stevenson co-founded Beach Guardian CIC in 2017 with her dad, Rob, which aims to engage, educate and empower against plastic pollution. Since its founding, Beach Guardian has organised over 200 community clean up events with over 6,000 volunteers; visited over 85 schools, engaging with over 14,000 school children and worked with some of the world's largest companies, to help them reduce their reliance on plastics, such as PepsiCo and Nissan.

Emily is also a budding environmental reporter, with her weekly Tune in Tuesday video blog reaching over a million people worldwide and features with BBC Spotlight highlighting the plights of plastic across the South West. In 2019, Emily's work received recognition as a Point of Light recipient from the British Prime Minister and was titled one of the Young Citizens of the Year by the Rotary Club in Great Britain and Ireland. In 2020, Emily was awarded the highest accolade a young person can achieve for social action and humanitarian efforts: the Diana Award. Emily is also currently on the MSc Conservation Science and Policy course at the University of Exeter, where she is undertaking a research project looking into the pathogenic and antibiotic resistant bacterial colonisation of microplastics from sites in Cornwall.

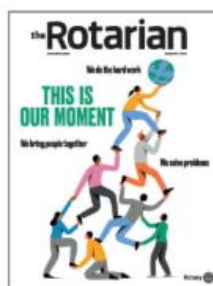
