Dr. Jacqueline ♦ Jackie ♦ Echols has been an environmental activist in support of water and tree protection for almost 25 years. In 1997, Dr. Echols helped to organize and provided leadership for the community-based grassroots organization, Clean Streams Task Force. The Task Force advocated for the elimination of Atlanta ♦ s combined sewer system as part of the Upper Chattahoochee Riverkeeper federal consent decree. The Task Force ♦ s advocacy did result in separating half or 9-miles of Atlanta ♦ s combined sewer system. It was during this time that Dr. Echols was introduced to the South River. Dr. Echols served on the Atlanta Tree Conservation Commission as a member and as chair from 2004-2006. In 2010, she assumed the role of Board President of South River Watershed Alliance. Over the last decade, the organization has strategically implemented programs such as Beyond the Bridge kayak and canoe paddles and South River Water Trail. These two programs form the foundation of SRWA ♦ s work to improve the South River ♦ s water quality through recreational use. In 2017, Dr. Echols received GreenLaw ♦ s Environmental Hero Award for her years of work and dedication to protecting the environment. Her favorite slogan is attributed to the founder of Patagonia, Yvon Chouinard, ♦ nothing will happen if you do nothing, so do something. ♦
