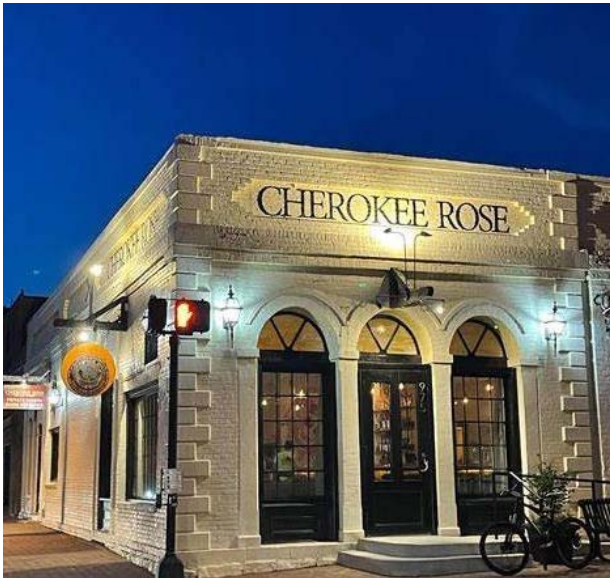

Funds and equipment collected from the event will support Friends of Disabled Adults and Children (FODAC), whose main program supplies HME to the mobility impaired and their caregivers, at little or no cost to the recipients.
