Foundation. A word that we hear mentioned often in our meetings. But what is it? Since it is Foundation month, I wanted to share its history, and why it is essential to the Rotary motto of Service Before Self.

1917- An endowment was created for the purpose of doing good in the world. First donation: \$26.50 (\$583 today)

1928- Renamed The Rotary Foundation

1929- The first gift of \$500 was given to the International Society for Crippled Children. This organization later grew into the Easter Seals. (\$7,616 today)

1978- Rotary introduced the Health, Hunger and Humanity (3-H) Grants. The first grant funded a project to immunize 6 million children against Polio in the Philippines.

1985- The PolioPlus program was created to eradicate polio worldwide.

2013- New district, global and package grants enable Rotarians to respond the world's greatest needs.

Since 1917, the Foundation has received contributions totaling more than \$1 billion dollars. 90.8% of all donations go directly to supporting service projects.

The Rotary Foundation was created to provide funding for the good that Rotarians do worldwide. Each year, \$100 from your dues is donated in your name to Foundation. You become a member of the Paul Harris Society after you donate \$1000. If you would like to donate on a recurring basis, please visit www.rotary.org/donate. Any accelerated payments will be matched by the club with points to get you to the Paul Harris level or \$1000. Reach out to Joanne for more information on how this is done.
