Tomorrow's Speaker ♦ Kevin Tanner-

House of Representative Career Kevin has spent 27 years in public service. He is serving in his fourth term as a State Representative for District 9, which includes Lumpkin County and parts of Dawson and Forsyth counties.

Prior to his first term as a state representative, Kevin was the Dawson County manager where he oversaw day-to-day operations as the county's chief operating officer. Kevin was recognized in 2011 as the appointed Official of the Year by Georgia's Association of County Commissioners. In 2007, Georgia Trend Magazine named Kevin one of Georgia's ♦40 Under 40. ♦ He has also been recognized as one of Dawson County's Citizens of the Year.

Kevin started his career with Dawson County as a volunteer fireman in 1989. He then worked for the Dawson Sheriff's Office in 1990 where he served in many positions, including 11 years as chief deputy/undersheriff, where he supervised all aspects of the department.

Kevin is a successful small business owner of a security company, where he provides armed and unarmed security guard services to various clients. He also owns Tanco Investments, LLC, a company with residential and commercial rental properties in several counties in North Georgia. Additionally, Kevin is a licensed light commercial contractor and primarily builds residential homes.

Kevin received his undergraduate degree from North Georgia College and State University and earned his Masters of Public Administration from Columbus State University.

In addition to his career, Kevin has been heavily involved in community and civic activities in the North Georgia area from many years. He served as the past vice chairman of the board of trustees for Chestatee Regional Hospital in Dahlonega and as a past member of the Rainbow Children's Home board in Dahlonega. Kevin is a current member of the executive board of the Northeast Georgia Boy Scout Council and was appointed by Governor Perdue to serve as the 9th congressional district representative on the State Board of Corrections. He has also served as the previous chairman and now serves as the vice chairman of the board of trustees of Lanier Technical College.
