November 8, 2021 Speaker: Bruce Azevedo, District 6910 Rotary Foundation Chair

Served as District Global Grants Coordinator, District Foundation Grants Service Chair, District Board of Director, District Bylaws, District Finance Committee, and District Strategic Plan Chair, and Assistant Governor for Areas IV & VI. He is a member of the Paul Harris Society, Bequest Society, Will Watt Fellow sustaining member, RLI graduate and recipient of The Rotary Foundation Citation for Meritorious Service Award. Bruce is a retired Navy Supply Chief Warrant Officer (CW03), and is married to the former Pamela Kidwell of San Angelo, Texas. They have two sons and two daughters, Neil, Ryan, Tabitha and Katrina. Neil has retired from the Navy and joined the family Real Estate business. Ryan is active duty Army SGT, Tabitha is medically retired from the Army after a helicopter crash in Iraq. 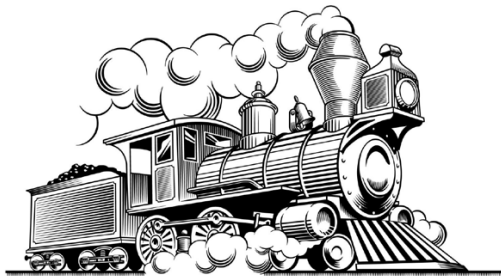
Happy Veteran's Day!
