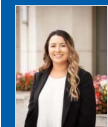

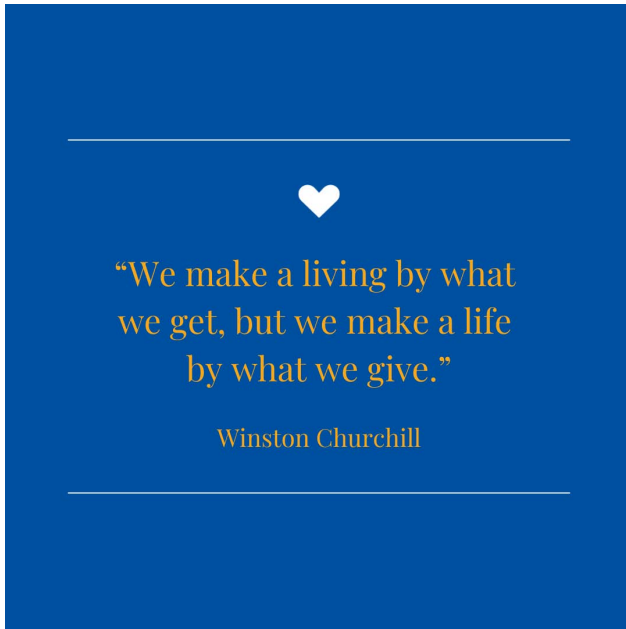


David Lynn

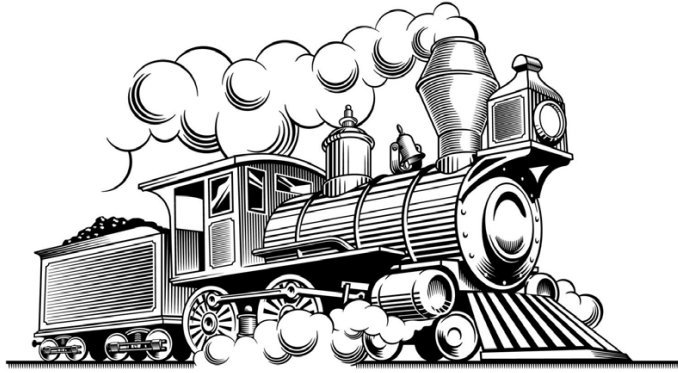
