Speaker for October 25, 2021: Milton Masciadri, Distinguished University Professor of Double Bass at the University of Georgia

Milton Masciadri is Distinguished University Professor of Double Bass at the University of Georgia, where he has been a member of the music faculty since 1984 and principal Bass of the Augusta Symphony since 1985.

Masciadri is a frequent recitalist and soloist with major symphony orchestras in Europe, Asia, North America, Central America and South America. He has presented master classes at such musical institutions as The Juilliard School, Manhattan School of Music, Paris Conservatoire, Guildhall School of Music in London, Moscow Conservatory, Federal University of Rio de Janeiro, Buenos Aires National Conservatory, and Milan Conservatorio among many others.

Masciadri recent performances included performances in Italy, Spain, France, Uruguay, Argentina, Brazil, Costa Rica, Colombia, Japan, Canada, Australia, Croatia and the United States. He has performed in Concert Halls as Carnegie Hall, New York, La Scala, Rio de Janeiro Opera and Buenos Aires Teatro Argentino, Italy.

In 2009 Dr. Masciadri received the title of University Professor of the University of Georgia, and he also holds the title of **"Accademico"** of the Accademia Filarmonica in Bologna, Italy ♦ Europe ♦s oldest musical educational institution. He has been awarded the Brazilian **Medal of Honor for Academic Achievements** for his musical and educational services to the people of Brazil, is listed in the ♦International Who's Who in Music ♦, in 1998 was designated a UNESCO Artist for Peace and in 2011 he received the Knighthood honor of the designation of Cavaglieri di San Marco in Venice. In 2015 Masciadri was Awarded the Leonardo da Vinci World Award for the Arts by the world Cultura Council, first musician to receive the award since its inception and in 2016 the University of Georgia Awarded him the SEC Academic Achievement Award

Masciadri performs on a 320 years old Testore double bass, appears in the International Who ♦s Who in Music and has solo recordings on DMR, ACA, Fondazione & Sinfonica Labels.

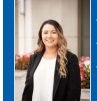

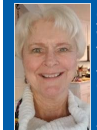

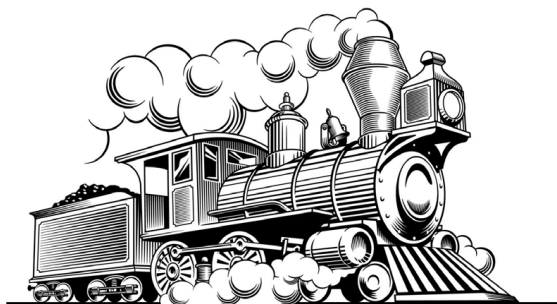
