Cheryl Legette, Chief Operations Officer, Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia Her story

Cheryl K. Legette is Chief Operating Officer for the Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia (GSHG) council which usually serves 13,000 girls and 5,000 volunteers in 125 counties (122 -GA, 2-SC, 1-AL). She is responsible for overseeing the Membership, Volunteer Management, Program and Property teams who are the frontline for delivering the Girl Scout program. Mrs. Legette helps develop and implement the council strategy to ensure all are focused on the organizational goals and clear about the mission.

Locally, she is involved in numerous community organizations with leadership responsibilities in many. In addition to her role as past President of the Athens club, Mrs. Legette serves as Rotary Assistant District Governor and has been a board member for several years. She also serves as Trustee of the Piedmont Health System, three-term Trustee and Vice Chair of the Piedmont Athens Regional Health System Board, Deacon and Chair of the Women's Ministry at Ebenezer Baptist Church, West and former Clarke County School Council and PTO member. When not busy working or with community activities, she can be found singing in the choir, her first love.

Mrs. Legette says Rotary has been an integral part of her life, with a motto that reflects her values- Service Above Self . She has spent her adult life working and volunteering with organizations that emphasize helping others, believing that serving others gives life meaning. Rotary has also played an important role in the life of her family. In fact, it was at one Thanksgiving luncheon that her then 10-year-old daughter proclaimed that she d be thankful for a dog if her parents would get her one! After vigorous campaigning by club members, Satchel, a black Labrador rescue, was adopted.

Mrs. Legette has over 25 years of non-profit management experience and holds master's degrees in both Social Work and Public Administration from Florida State University.
