Jim Hammond is the artistic and managing director of the Gainesville Theatre Alliance. He was one of the first graduates of the theater collaboration of UNG and Brenau University and received his Master of Fine Arts from the University of Louisville.

He is a Professor of Theatre at University of North Georgia and Brenau University. Duties include teaching theatre courses, and artistic and

administrative leadership of the collaborative program coordinating 10 faculty and 6 staff members and a \$400,000 budget.

Gainesville Theatre Alliance is a nationally acclaimed collaboration between the University of North Georgia, Brenau University, Theatre Professionals and the Northeast Georgia Community. Their ensemble of students, community members and professionals recognize learning and growth as its primary goal.

Jim will be retiring soon but promises he will be sitting next to us in the audience rather than giving the curtain speech. He is forever grateful for the love and support we have given to the work of the Gainesville Theatre Alliance though the years.
