November 9th, Our own Chuck Bullock will give us an election update



CHARLES S. BULLOCK, III, holds the Richard B. Russell Chair in Political Science and is Josiah Meigs Distinguished Teaching Professor and University Professor of Public and International Affairs at the University of Georgia. He has been at the University of Georgia since 1968 with the exception two years when he was Professor of Political Science at the University of Houston. In 2005 and 2009 he was a senior fellow at Oxford University's Rothermere American Institute.

In 2015, Dr. Bullock was named University Professor, an honor bestowed on faculty who have had a significant impact on the University of Georgia beyond normal academic responsibilities. The honor was first awarded in 1974, and no more than one University Professor can be named in any year.

Bullock is author, co-author, editor or co-editor of more than 30 books and more than 250 articles and chapters. He has published in major political science, public administration and education journals. Among his most recent books are *Redistricting: The Most Political Activity in America* (2010), *The New Politics of the Old South*, 6th edition (2018), co-edited with Mark Rozell, *Triumph of Voting Rights in the South* (2009), co-authored with Keith Gaddie, *Georgia Politics in a State of Change*, 3rd edition (2020) also written with Keith Gaddie and the *Oxford Handbook of Southern Politics* co-edited with Mark Rozell (2012). The *Triumph of Voting Rights in the South* and *Runoff Elections in the United States*, co-authored with Loch Johnson, have each won the V. O. Key Award for being the best book on southern politics published in a particular year.

Bullock's teaching and research specialties are legislative politics and southern politics. He has been recognized for outstanding teaching by the Department of Political Science, the Honors Program, and the Student Government Association. In 1993, Bullock was one of four professors in the College of Arts and Sciences to receive its highest teaching award. He was named the outstanding professor in the School of Public and International Affairs in 2003. In 2005 he won the University of Georgia's highest teaching award.

He has received research grants from the National Science Foundation, the National Institute of Education, the Pew Charitable Trusts and the American Enterprise Institute. His research has won awards from the Southern Political Science Association, the Southwest Political Science Association and the Georgia Political Science Association. In 1991, Bullock received the William A. Owens Creative Research Award presented by the University of Georgia.

Bullock has served as a consultant to the attorneys general in 11 states and to more than 70 states and local governments. Since the 1970s, he has consulted on statewide redistricting litigation in more than a dozen states.

In 2011 and 2012 Georgia Trend Magazine recognized Bullock as one of the 100 most influential Georgians. Bullock also made James's Magazine's 2012 Most Influential list.

Click the link (you may have to CTRL + click OR copy and paste the link into your web browser) and you will see that the home page takes you through registering for everything you need the conference, your hotel room and activities! Steps 1, 2 and 3! If you want to stay in the event hotel, which is the Hyatt Regency Greenville, you need to secure your room AS SOON AS POSSIBLE before they sell out. I am told there are plenty of rooms available as of now but who knows when the booking rush will happen.

PLEASE NOTE, if you're not ready to register for the conference but want to have a hotel room secured, you can book your hotel room prior to registering for the conference. If you want to just book your hotel room now, see Step #2 below.

Steps to take:

1. Register for the conference. Remember, our club is Club Number 4175. Shortly after completing your registration and submitting online payment, you should receive an email confirmation of your registration receipt. (You may have to allow popup blockers to proceed to the Pay By Credit Card page when registering.)
2. Book your room in the event hotel The Hyatt Regency on the conference registration website above or call Nicole directly at 864-298-2446, group code G-6910. If you want to add on additional nights before or after 4/21 - 4/24, you should discuss this with Nicole to get the group rate. You cannot add on dates through the conference registration website, if you want the conference rate for extra nights outside of April 21, 22 or 23. At least this was my experience.
3. Register for any activities you would like to experience. See the website for full details on each activity and make your selections during the registration process.
