President Elbert called on Karla Redding Andrews and Bowen Shoemaker to introduce our club's newest member. Karla came to the microphone and introduced to our members her "first born" Justin Andrews. Justin was described by Karla as someone who will be a true asset to our club that talks to and loves everyone. He will hold the classification Music Heritage-Additional.



President Elbert called on President Elect Susan Welsh, needing no introduction, to present her program on Macon's Stained Glass. Susan presented members with a slide show and description of some of Macon's precious stained glass church windows. She focused on Christ Church with several from St Paul's Church.

The stained glass windows were originally created to control incoming light and at the same time narrate the Bible for the uneducated. They were at first stained on painted onto the glass surface until Tiffany created a process to mold the colors into the glass.

Macon's Christ Church has many excellent examples of the painted and Tiffany glass windows. These are excellent examples of Christian symbolism. Susan

illustrated this symbolism in her slides giving members an explanation of the symbolism. The stories depicted in the windows always "read" from top to bottom.

Susan's knowledge and excellent interpretation of the symbolism and stories of the stained glass kept the attention of members in attendance. If you missed the program you missed an opportunity to gain knowledge of some of Macon's artistic treasures.

President Elbert closed the meeting with members reciting the 4 Way Test.

#### **Excused Absence**

Members have the opportunity to receive a board approved Excused Absence during a long-term family, health, or business crisis. When a member realizes they have a situation that will keep them from attending Monday meetings for an extended period they can contact the Club Administrator or President with the reason. This contact needs to be immediate and not after the crisis. The board can approve a beginning and ending date and attendance is excused on club and district level. Short term absences are best made up online as indicated below.

#### HOW TO MAKE UP MISSED MEETINGS

Please make up missed meetings to help our club's attendance percentage rank with District 6920 and Rotary International. Our attendance is reported each month to the district and is required to be reported before the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month. Members are required to maintain an attendance average of 60%.

Missed meetings must be made up 14 days before or after the meeting you miss, it is in our club's Constitution!
