Legislative Update

Freshman Representative John Snyder helped pass a \$101.5 billion state budget his first term! The increase was helped by additional federal funds received by the state, he said. He also worked to award first responders and teachers additional funds for the year. He said that our teacher



salaries have improved and we are now one of the top 5 states in the nation.

More people are choosing to move to FL for both jobs and retirement. He worked on funding for the IRSC Advanced Workforce Training Complex of \$10.6 million!

The governor just signed the Civic Education Curriculum Act (HB5) This bill will help create a civic education curriculum for K-12 students to help them understand their shared rights and responsibilities as citizens.

Other legislation he has been involved in includes Social Media Platforms (SB7072) and Combating Public Disorder (HB1) to protect our neighborhoods and citizens.

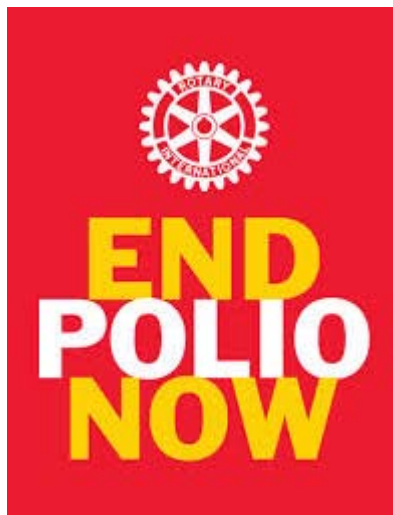
John is a graduate of Indiana Wesleyan University and served in
