Josh the Baby Otter Water Safety Program

The "Josh the Baby Otter" Water Safety Program is designed to keep children safe around the water and to prevent accidental drowning of children. The children's book, Josh the Baby Otter, available in both English and Spanish, is a story about a young otter who learns to float on his back in the water by being taught by his mother. He also is never in or near the water without his mother or a buddy. The Joshua Collinsworth Foundation provides for a nominal charge a Josh the Baby Otter coloring book and sticker, to further reinforce this message and remind the children of what they learned from Josh the Baby Otter.

Led by Christine Moreno, Stuart Rotary Club members are **introducing the Josh the Baby Otter Water Safety Program to area children under the age of 6. Beginning in 2019 and continuing through the school year Club**

members will start presenting this water safety program and distributing 250 booklets at our local public schools and public library children's reading program.
