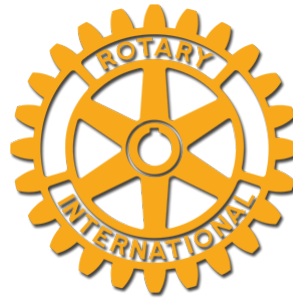

Since 1982 Treasure Coast Hospice has been serving those in need of an integrated approach to end of life care.

Craig Perry from their foundation spoke about the need for hospice care and all that it encompasses. Treasure Coast Hospice includes Martin, St. Lucie, and Okeechobee Counties. Their average case load is 400 plus patients per day.

It is a way of providing holistic care not only to the patient but the family. Care is mostly provided in your home and focuses on the quality of life of the patient. Hospice care does not prolong life or hasten death. It is a way for the patient and their family to have good experiences during a difficult period.

While in the past hospice care was thought of only in the final weeks of life, today it can begin six months before the end stages of life. What I took from Craig's talk is that hospice care provides a guide on the final road for the patient and their loved ones. As the inevitable for everyone of us becomes reality, it is nice to know there can be someplace to turn for help as we face our final act.
