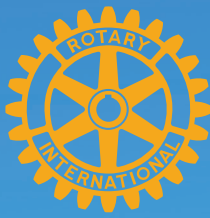

October 21, 2020

Today we welcome our very own Brent Simon with some fishing stories and tips.

Last Week's Meeting

Our speaker last week, introduced by Evie Parks, was our very own Kristen King, coordinator for Keep Pasco Beautiful. Kristen began with, "I am the tree hugger of the group and my mission is to improve Pasco County." The purpose of a clean up is not only to collect trash, but also teach litter prevention. What they see is that the families that help with the coastal clean up, continue to keep cleaning throughout the year. An example of this is Nora George and her sons, Dallas and Leo who join them every year. The kids, when on the beach, are always looking for trash to pick up.

Kristen then told us about the process of putting a coastal clean up together. You have to secure sponsors, coordinate captains, marketing and promotion, manage volunteers, order and distribute supplies and coordinate with the haulers to take away the trash collected. In 2020 there were 922 volunteers, 3,248 volunteer hours, 19.52 tons of trash collected and 36 separate locations. The cost benefit of volunteer hours was over \$280,000.00. Kristen said, "Collaboration is the key to a successful clean up." They work with Rotary Clubs, the cities of New Port Richey, Port Richey, and Dade City, as well as schools, churches Boys & Girls clubs, and

any other group that wants to get involved and help.

Derek thanked Kristen for an interesting and informative program. A donation to the local Pack-a-Sack program will be made in her name.

Veterans' Day Update

This year we will not be doing our regular Veterans' Day Program due to health and safety concerns. However, we still want to make sure that we recognize what Veterans in our community have done for our country. Greg Wegener and his committee have been working on a plan to honor and support some of our veterans most in need.

Greg has been in contact with both Meals on Wheels in Pasco County and the Baldomero Lopez State Veterans' Facility in Land O'Lakes. Meals on Wheels is serving approximately 130 veterans and the Veterans' Facility has about 120 residents. Our Club will be working with these organizations to make sure their veterans are recognized for their service.

Packages will be made for each veteran. For the Meals on Wheels veterans we will be doing a custom bag with our Club's name and logo and a thank you on it. It will include a challenge coin, a handwritten thank you card, and hygiene items. Hygiene items were requested by the Meals on Wheels supervisor as something that is always needed and appreciated.

For the Veterans at Baldemero, we will do packages that include a gift bag, a challenge

coin, a handwritten thank you and a Tervis cup with a message on it or some other item. In addition, through his conversations with the managers there, Greg and his committee are looking at possibly planting trees and placing a plaque there, putting up banners with words of recognition and thanks for residents to see from their windows, re-doing 5 benches that are no longer usable and donating a large number of higher quality adult incontinence items than the veterans receive from the state funding there.

Haunted House Tour

from Reader's Digest

If you are feeling adventurous and want to travel and have some scary fun (sometime next year), here are three of the spookiest haunted houses in the world to visit.

Mínxióng Ghost House — Mínxióng, Taiwan

Ranked as the spookiest haunted house in 2019, the Minxiong Ghost House naturally lives up to its reputation. The stories surrounding this mansion run the gauntlet from affairs to suicide to simple relocation, but whatever you believe, this mansion definitely fits the creepy bill. Built in 1929 by Liu Rongyu, this baroque rival style mansion (sometimes called the Old Liu House) is hidden between overgrown greenery. One of the most popular tales states that a housemaid had an affair with the homeowner, leading to the wrath of the wife and eventual death of the maid by jumping down a nearby well. If the maid story was not enough, another story claims a soldier committed suicide in the home after hearing strange voices. Regardless of the truth long lost to time, the large mansion has some wild history within its beautiful, yet decaying walls.

Chaonei No. 81 — Beijing, China

Built in the early 20th century, this mansion has a much darker past. Constructed in the baroque style by the Qing imperial family, this three-story mansion has been abandoned since 1949. The story goes that after the Nationalists' defeat by the Communists, the Kuomin-

tang official who owned the property abandoned his wife in the mansion. According to legend, she was so wrought with anguish and heartache that she hanged herself in the home. Some say that her spirit still haunts the house, as explorers and local children alike dare to take a peek inside the once elegant and now-decaying home.

Villa de Vecchi — Cortenova, Italy

This beautiful mansion sits among the trees in the mountains of Cortenova, beside Lake Como. Known by many nicknames, including the "Red House, Ghost Mansion, and Casa Delle Streghe (The House of Witches)," this mansion touts a tragic history. In the late 19th century, Count Felix De Vecchi commis-

sioned architect Alessandro Sidoli to build this Baroque-style behemoth. Unfortunately for the Count, Sidoli died a year before the top-of-the-line villa was completed.

The Vecchi family spent very little time in the villa before tragedy struck—the Count's wife was murdered and daughter kidnapped. After a number of search attempts, the Count himself succumbed to suicide. After passing hands around the Vecchi family for a few decades, the house fell to disrepair, nature intrusion, and vandalism. Still, the mansion lives on in lore to this day. Alongside the rumors of occult activities and sacrifices, locals still say the long-ago smashed piano still floats music outside of the house and down the countryside.

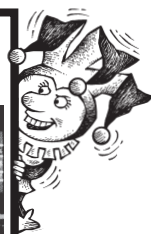
