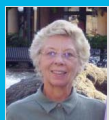

Sargent At Arms	<p>ALL ROTARIANS & GUESTS MUST WEAR MASKS TO ENTER THE HALL</p> <p>Temperature Check for each Rotarian/Guest</p> <p>Sargent At Arms and anyone at the entry table to wear a mask</p> <p>ALL ROTARIANS to sanitize hands w/provided sanitizer</p> <p>Rotarian to sign COVID19 waiver (1x) and complete the health form</p> <p>Rotarian gets their own badge from the board</p> <p>Suspend sale of 50/50 tickets</p> <p>Sargent At Arms reminds Rotarians of Social Distancing upon entry</p>
Tables/Seating	<p>Maximum FOUR Rotarians per table</p> <p>Room capacity is 300. 25% is 75. Normal attendance is approx. 35</p> <p>Bulletins will be on-line only</p> <p>Sanitizer will be located on each table</p>
Food Service	<p>Full Breakfast service based on CDC guidelines and at the direction of Geroge Bessler</p> <p>Masks may be removed while eating or drinking</p>
Meeting	<p>Room set up and full sanitation is done in advance by the Church custodian</p> <p>6' distance around all tables</p> <p>Connect Zoom and display on the screen for those who are not comfortable attending</p> <p>Rotarians keep their badges and bring them back for next meeting</p> <p>After meeting dismiss Rotarians one table at a time</p> <p>No close contact congregating before, during, or after the meeting</p> <p>ALL Rotarians to sanitize hands w/provided sanitizer upon departure</p>
