Guest Speaker



Our program this week is hosted by Club Member Wally Hopkins and our speaker is David Jolly. Mr. Jolly is an attorney, former lobbyist, and politician who served as the U.S. Representative for Florida's 13th congressional district, based in Pinellas County.

David served in the U.S. House of Representatives from 2014 ♦ 2017, representing Pinellas County. A student of the institution, Jolly has held virtually every position in Congress, from intern to Member, and has worked outside the Congress as a practicing securities attorney, a principal in specialty finance and private equity, and as a consultant and manager on multiple federal campaigns. Today, Jolly serves as Executive Vice President of Shumaker Advisors Florida, and as a Political Analyst for the networks and media platforms of NBC Universal.

Known for his fierce independent streak and bipartisan approach, Jolly ♦s work has been published in Time, USA Today, Roll Call, the Washington Post, CNN.com, NBCNews.com, NewsMax, the Washington Times, and the Tampa Bay Times.

David received his Bachelor of Arts from Emory University in 1994, and his Juris Doctor Cum Laude from George Mason University in 2001.
