FHP is the lead state law enforcement agency. We have state wide jurisdiction. We do respond to similar calls. We have daily interaction with local law enforcement agencies.

Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, 11 troops. We are on all federal, state, county and local roadways. There are 67 counties. I have 188 troopers in Troop F.

We have one centralized academy located in Tallahassee. Academy is 29 weeks long with 14-week field training. The application process is rigorous. It is very military-like. Afterwards they take state boards. We try to produce the best possible officers.

What does a trooper do? Monitor and control traffic, respond to natural disasters and riot, respond to calls, make arrests, and patrol assigned areas. We serve felony warrants. We do community outreach and are very involved in our communities.
