# Speaker Highlights July 1st, 2021 District Governor Andy Lyman

# "Serve To Change Lives"

July 1 is the official start of Rotary's year in the United States. Terms for officers commence, the fiscal year begins, etc. On this day, the first official act of our newly sworn-in Rotary District 6960 Governor, Andy Lyman, was visiting our club, via zoom, and swearing in our club's officers.

DG Lyman began his comments by praising the leadership and many accomplishments of retiring President, Linda Sandlin. Not only did she preside over the club during the most challenging time of our club's history by navigating us through the Covid - 19 pandemic, DG Lyman said, but she also completed a reorganization of the club's structure that would assure a smooth transition of power to the next President. With those comments, DG Lyman swore-in Linda's successor, Cindy Love-Abounader and her slate of officers.

DG Lyman continued praising our club for its many successes during a year when clubs, not only in our country but also throughout the world, were challenged by learning how to meet via ZOOM, raising funds for their various charities, and enjoying fellowship among their members.

He concluded his comments with four leadership principles that he encouraged us to practice:

Self-Awareness - understanding our personal values, strengths, weaknesses, behavior;

Communication - verbal, non-verbal, and written;

Influence - especially in our community; "service to our community;" Learning Agility - keeping our minds open to new ideas and learning new practices.
