There are several courses available.

Part One: The Rotarian – Introduction to the RLI experience. Emphasis is placed on providing an overview of Rotary programs and helping develop ideas that participants can take back to their Rotary Clubs. Courses include Object of Rotary, Rotary - The Bigger Picture, Membership Retention, Rotary Opportunities, Ethics and Vocational Service, and Rotary Foundation.

Part Two: The Rotary Club – The depth of subject matter increases and focus is on fostering the qualities of a knowledgeable Rotarian by building on the basics learned in Part I. It includes an individual analysis of your Rotary Club. Courses include Analyzing your Rotary Club, Leadership - team building, strategic planning, service projects, membership attraction, and public relations.

Part Three: The Rotary Journey – The final phase of RLI, is much more in-depth and detailed. Learn about opportunities available to you and your club through RI and how to best utilize them. Understand what it means to be a Rotarian and how you can use your RLI knowledge to better serve your club. Courses include Rotary History, International Service, Leadership, Effective Strategies, Rotary Foundation II, Communication Techniques, and Making a Difference.
