We have attached an Option Election Form for you to select which option you prefer and return the signed election. Keep in mind this option of reimbursement only applies if you have in fact paid your dues.

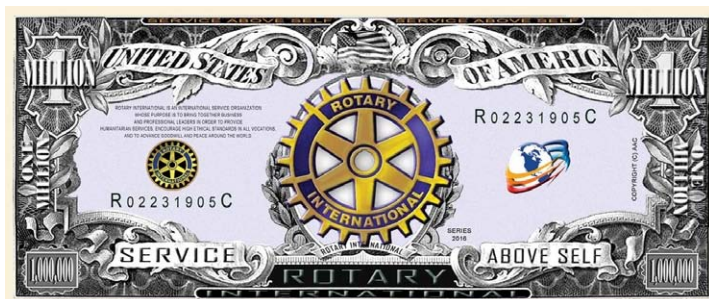
We thank you for your kind patience in waiting for these options. These are challenging times.

President Richard Green's Acceptance Speech

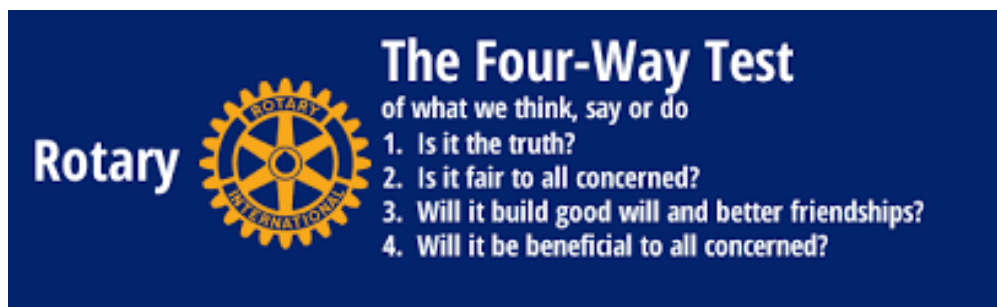
Here is a copy of Richard's very moving Acceptance Speech from this past week.
