## Road Kill

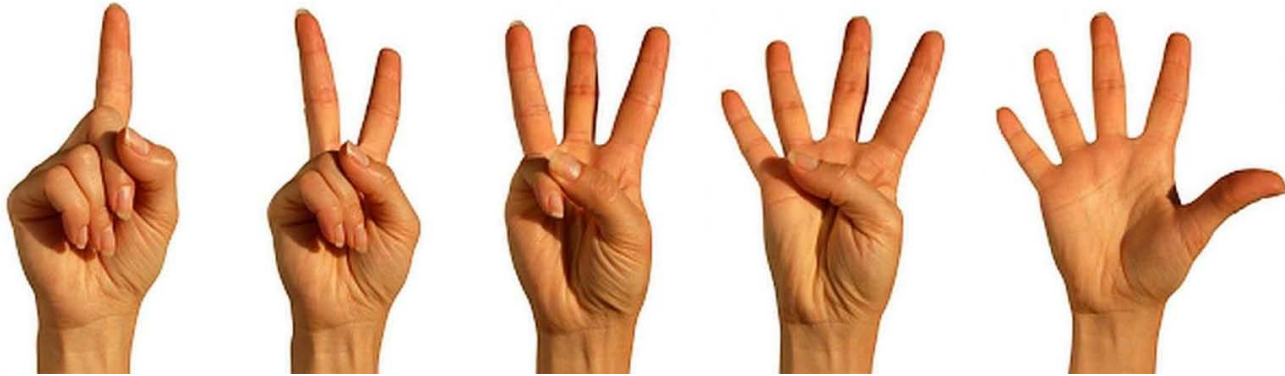

## Friday's Speaker: Kevin Dolan, Cancer Alliance of Naples



This week's speaker is Kevin Dolan,  
Chief Executive Officer, Cancer Alliance of Naples (serving Collier & Lee counties).

Mr. Dolan will be describing the mission and services offered by the non-profit organization, Cancer Alliance of Naples, (CAN). The Cancer Alliance of Naples was incorporated 19 years ago with the simple mission of "neighbors helping neighbors". Kevin has been with CAN for 17 years, both serving as a board member and volunteer. Kevin was the Board President for 3 years and last October stepped in as CEO.

CAN assists families dealing with the ravages of cancer and helps families in all of Lee and Collier county. As of June, CAN will offer services to the children of Glades and Hendry county.

Kevin has lived in Naples for 31 years with his wife Gail and recently retired from financial services.
