## Road Kill is Killing It!

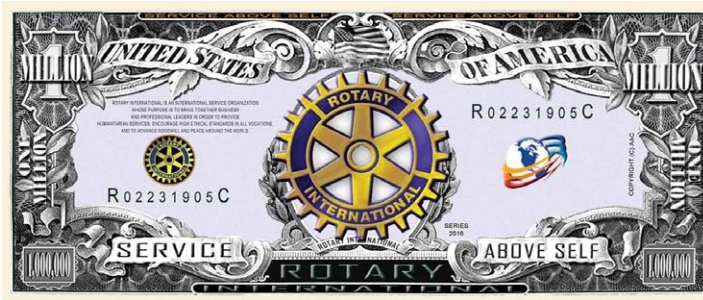

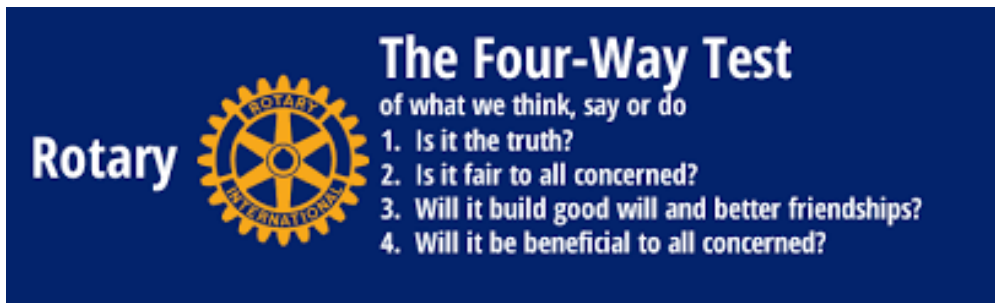
