FISH OF SANCAP, in partnership with the City of Sanibel, CHR, Sanibel-Captiva Rotary Club, and the Sanibel Community Association (SCA) distributed COVID Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) kits to all community members on Wednesday September 30 and Thursday October 1.

The City of Sanibel received an allotment of disposable facemasks, reusable cloth facemasks, and a 16oz bottle of hand sanitizer from Lee County, is partnering with FISH, CHR, The Rotary Club of Sanibel-Captiva, and the Sanibel Community House to distribute to the community.
