Current Observations from The Rotary Foundation

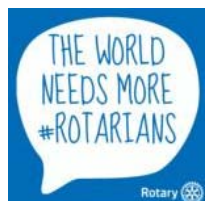


At the end of the day, did we do good in the world? Our Rotary world, as we knew it, changed. Many Rotarians changed. Many grew bigger hearts. District 6960, despite the COVID 19 pandemic, set records. We hit an all time high for total giving of \$1,458,360 (11.2% increase) that placed our District at #6 in the world. Our Annual Fund giving topped over 1 million dollars for the first year ever and landed at \$1,015,627 (4% increase). For the first time in over five years, each of our clubs contributed to The Rotary Foundation. Our PolioPlus Fund received an all time high of \$119,539 from 41 clubs, a 28.2% increase from the prior year. The Endowment Fund garnered \$259,607 representing a 19.4% increase.
