Youth & Peace in Action

How can Rotarians support local communities to be more peaceful, resilient, and collaborative? Each year, **Peace and Conflict Prevention / Resolution** is the theme for February within Rotary International. This year, the theme will come to life in a unique and inspiring way in Zones 33 & 34. A signature initiative called **Youth & Peace in Action: Engaging 100,000 Young Community Peacebuilders** (or, **YPA**) is underway with a goal of a majority of Districts working together to support and provide local/District peace education tools, resources and training to high school students, teachers and Rotarians.

More than 20 Districts contributed to the planning phase in 2020. Throughout February, Rotarians across Zones 33 & 34 will benefit from presentations, tools and templates about YPA and be invited to officially join in the initiative from March 2021 through June 2022. This includes: connecting and sharing this news with local communities; a virtual event for thousands of teachers, students and Rotarians on International Day of Peace (Sept. 21); access to peace education professional development for Social Studies and Environmental Science teachers; and NewGen Peacebuilders certification training for students in high school service clubs. The year will culminate in a Zones-wide virtual celebration of peace projects.
