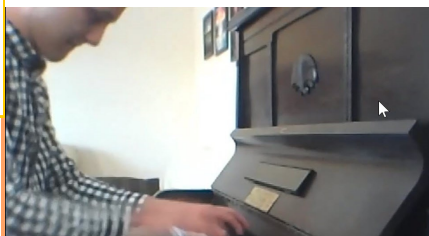

What a fantastic way to start the day! We had a group of 87



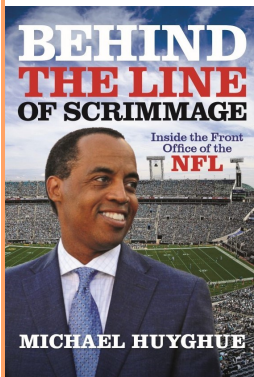

## April 23rd Program: We're Zooming!



*Guest Speaker:* Michael L. Huyghue, NFL Sports Executive on the NFL Draft, which begins Thursday Night.

Michael Huyghue (HEWG) is widely regarded as one of the most prominent figures in the professional sports industry having a career that spans over 30 years. Mr. Huyghue was twice named to the Sports Business Journal's Top 40 Under 40 Sports Executives. Mr. Huyghue has been a pioneer in the industry, paving the way for many other African Americans who followed in his footsteps. Mr. Huyghue is currently President of his own boutique Sports Management and Consulting Agency headquartered in Jacksonville, Florida. Most recently, Mr. Huyghue was the Commissioner

of the United Football League, that was comprised primarily of young National Football League players and former NFL Head Coaches. Mr. Huyghue, founded and directed the UFL raising over two hundred million dollars in seed money. The UFL operated for four nationally televised seasons, competing directly against the NFL. The UFL saw limited viewership but over 150 of its players and dozens of its coaches found full time starting positions within the NFL, including the current Head Coach and Offensive Coordinator of the Washington Redskins.

A lawyer by training, Mr. Huyghue attended the University of Michigan Law School, earning his Juris Doctor degree in 1987. Mr. Huyghue was a standout four sport athlete in high school in Windsor, Connecticut, and was selected into its Hall of Fame. Mr. Huyghue was recruited in athletics by many colleges and universities and chose Cornell University where he played varsity football and freshman baseball. Mr. Huyghue was elected to the Board of Trustees at Cornell and is listed among its Distinguished Alumni. Mr. Huyghue currently serves as a Visiting Law Professor at the Cornell Law School.

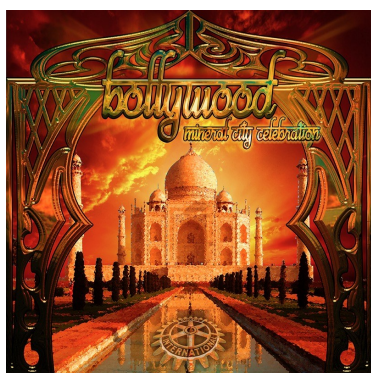
