Sen. Rob Bradley-Chair of the Senate Appropriations Committee

Raised in Green Cove Springs, Senator Rob Bradley is a fourth generation North Florida native. A graduate of Clay High School, he attended the University of Florida where he graduated with a B.S. in 1992 and earned his law degree in 1996. Senator Bradley is the managing partner of Bradley, Garrison & Komando, P.A., a law firm in Orange Park. He is Board Certified by the Florida Bar as an Expert in City, County and Local Government Law. He also served as an Assistant

State Attorney in the Fourth Judicial Circuit prior to entering private practice.

Senator Bradley is married to Jennifer Bradley, and they have three children. Son, Connor, a graduate of the University of North Florida, daughter Stephanie, a recent UF graduate, and Caroline, who is attending the University of Florida.

Prior to his service in the Florida Senate, Senator Bradley served on the Clay County Commission and as a member of the Board of Trustees for St. Johns River State College. A Republican, he was elected unopposed for his second term in the Senate. Senator Bradley represents Senate District Five, which encompasses eleven counties in North Florida. He has served as Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee from 2017 to the present and also serves on the Finance & Taxation Committee, Rules Committee and the Committee on Innovation, Industry & Technology. He is also alternating Chair of the Joint Legislative Budget Commission.

Senator Bradley is an avid Gator and Jaguars fan. He also enjoys golfing, outdoor activities and spending as much time as possible with his wife and children.
