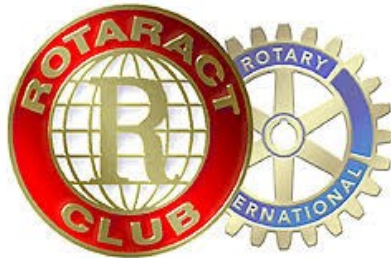

Turn off notifications - each ping is a distraction to you and meeting participants.
