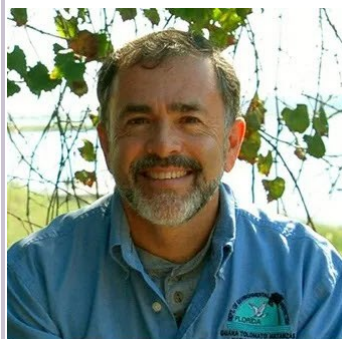
Rotarian of the Month

Since 2007, Dr. Michael Shirley has held the position of director at the Guana Tolomato Matanzas National Estuarine Research Reserve (GTM Research Reserve) and has served as the NE Regional Program Administrator for ORCP's North East Coast Aquatic Preserve Program. Mike started his professional career as a staff scientist for Save the Bay Inc. (Rhode Island) in 1980. During his graduate studies, he worked at the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center and EPA's Gulf Ecology Division Laboratory. Mike has also held positions as a research biologist, resource management coordinator and research coordinator at the Rookery Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve in Naples, Florida. He has held adjunct faculty appointments with Florida Gulf Coast University, Florida International University, Florida Southwestern State College, and Hodges University. Mike has a Ph.D. in marine science with a minor in environmental toxicology from North Carolina State University, a Master of Science in biology from the University of West Florida, and a Bachelor of Science in zoology from the University of Rhode Island. Mike has two adult children, Rachel and Emily. His wife, Kathy, teaches seventh and eighth grade science at Valley Ridge Academy in St. Johns County, Florida.
