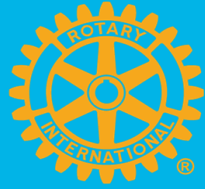

Prior to joining JEA,

Jay was the CEO of Stowe Utility Group in Chattanooga, Tennessee, where he provided consulting services in support of utility operations, business and functional needs to community-owned utilities across the Southeast and Midwest. He has also served in C-level roles and senior vice president roles for the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) and Huntsville (Alabama) Utilities. Under Jay's leadership, Huntsville Utilities grew to become the 15th largest public gas system in the country, the 20th largest public electric system in the country and one of the largest water systems in the Southeast.



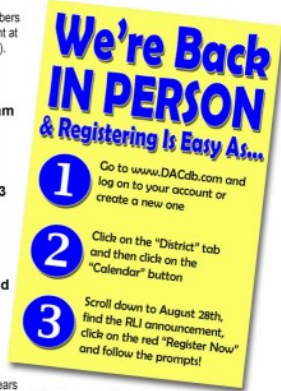
Rotary Leadership Institute

Mark Your Calendars for Cocktails and Croquet

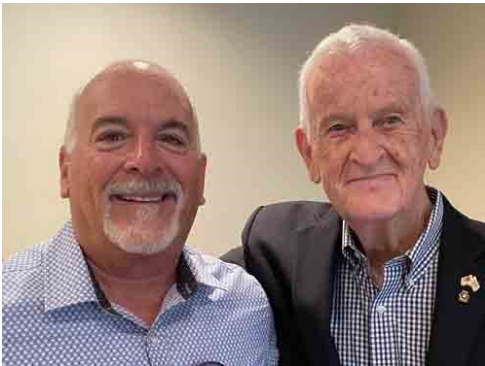
Date: October 23rd
