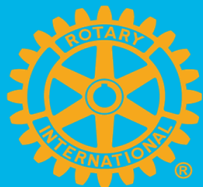

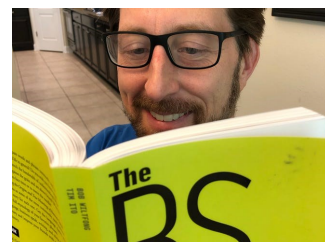

Rich Cooper is a Native Floridian and resides in Palm Coast, with his wife Nancy. Rich works for Foundation Risk Partners in Daytona Beach, a national independent insurance 'intermediary. Rich and Nancy have 3 nearly grown children, Alex (23), Christopher (21) and Gabriella (18).

Prior to Rich entering his career in the Insurance Industry in 2002, he was a professional fire fighter and paramedic for 10 years. Upon retirement from the fire service, Rich joined his family business running a local insurance agency in Ormond

Beach. In 2009 upon his father's retirement, Rich took over operations of the agency and ran it successfully until selling the agency to a group of executives that wanted to start a new national company. That company is now 18th largest independent agency in the US, after just four short years. Rich has been a member of the Rotary Club of Ormond Beach since 2002 and served as club president in 2012. Rich has also served in several district positions including Area Governor, Sergeant-At-Arms, CART Chair and District Treasurer. Location: Foot of Mosquito Control Road, A1A (Mosquito Control Road is just past Elementary School, across highway from Al's Pizza)

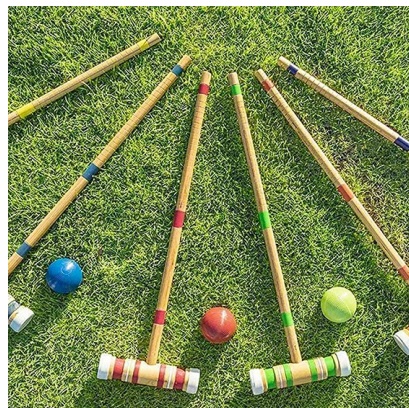

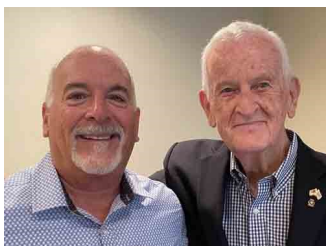
