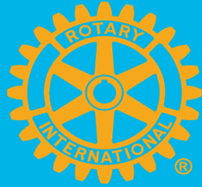

August 26th Program:



Neal Benson has for more than 40 years been helping not-for-profits across the country to create strategic development plans and secure funding sources to achieve those plans. Coaxed out of retirement, he joined the Ark of the St. Johns in St Augustine FL, in February of 2008 as the agency's first director of marketing and development. Neal directed financial development campaigns of \$1.3 million for a new building for the Arks Therapeutic Learning Center for children; And \$1.8 million for Safe Harbor, a new 6,250 square foot hurricane shelter and specialized classroom facility for young adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities and other special needs. Safe Harbor was opened and dedicated on August 12th, 2021. Neal has been honored with the Arc of Florida's President's award and earned top honors for marketing, communications, and financial development. Neal is a Vietnam veteran and accomplished public speaker trainer of not-for-profit leaders and staff and a published author.

Lori Anderson started as Executive Director of Beaches Council on Aging on July 6th, 2020. She took over for Gary Tiller who was ED for the past 3 years. Lori has spent the last 10 years as Executive Director of Mission House, the only day facility in the Beaches area helping homeless residence. She grew the organization from 6 staff members to 16 and increased the budget from \$358,000 in 2010 to \$928,000 in 2020. She is originally from the San Francisco Bay Area in California. Lori is honored to be a part of this incredibly dedicated and service-oriented team. We want to grow the service part of our organization by becoming the agency to turn to when our seniors and disabled residents are in need.

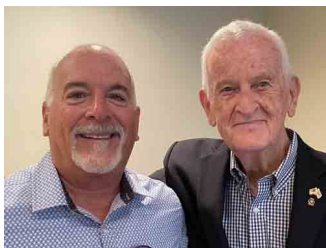
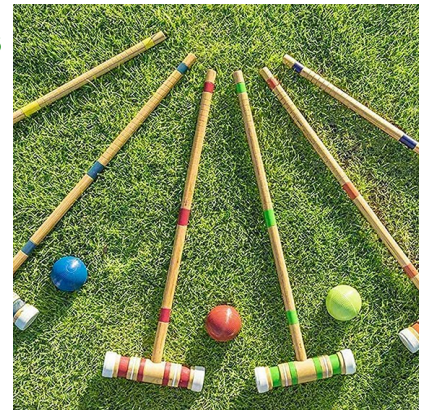
